## Key Curriculum Objectives

## <u>English</u>

Basic writing skills. Please ensure these are always included when completing homework:

- Capital letters
- Full stops/exclamation marks/question marks
- Finger spaces
- Spelling of Common Exception Words (CEW) please see back of School Diary
- Dictated sentences (including key spellings)
- Cursive (joined) handwriting.
- This half term, we will investigate the structures of non-fiction texts.
- We will also look at recounts and diary entries, focusing on the key features

## <u>Maths</u>

We will be continuing with our Power Maths - a whole-class mastery programme designed to spark curiosity and excitement and help nurture confidence in maths.

Year 3: Rapid recall of the 2,3,4,5,8 and 10 times tables.

Fractions, Measurements and Shapes.

Year 4: Rapid recall of all the times tables

Decimals, Money and Time.
