1 Year Anniversary

This Sunday will mark the first anniversary of the school fire. Parking

We have been made aware that some of our parents and carers have been parking near one of the local businesses by Shelton House, blocking the front gates and preventing access for their workers. Please can we remind our families to use the parking locations listed below, avoiding Fox Street:

St. Mary's Church car park, Darley Lane (6 minute walk to school)
Parker's Piece Car park, City Road, DE1 1DF (4/5 minute walk to school)
City Road (free parking for 30 minutes)

Also, parents and carers are not allowed to drop off or pick children up on site unless disabled access has been granted to them by school.

Open Day

This year, we will be holding 'Open Day Sessions' over the course of a week for new parents with children starting school in September 2022. If you know of anyone who has children of this age who is currently choosing schools for their child, please signpost them to our 'Open Week' week commencing Monday 11 October.
