Last Friday, Class 10 shared a lovely and thought provoking Act of Worship where the focus was on 'self-discipline'. The children talked about their learning in the Lent term and how they showed self-discipline when keeping their Lenten promises; furthermore, having the self-discipline to meet their goals. Class 10 shared their artic skills through some wonderful drawings of Good Friday and the Resurrection.

Also last week, the school participated in a 'Walk for Hunger'. The children in FS and KS1 managed several laps of the playground showing a super effort in their bid to raise money for CAFOD. The staff and children in KS2 walked around the local area walking a distance of approximately 3KM. A huge thank you to our families for your support with this fundraising event; the children raised just over £180 for CAFOD where we hope will help those in need across the world. Many thanks also to our families and carers for all the food and clothing donations we have received so far; your generosity has been overwhelming. Please keep them coming in. We have managed to donate 7 food hampers so far to the Padley Centre and the Refugee Centre. The uniform rack is looking full too. We will continue the theme of parties and celebration as we mark Pentecost – the birthday of the church on Monday 6th June where we hope to be able to invite parents and carers in to join in the celebrations.
