Catholic Life: Faith in Action

Last Thursday, Class 7 shared a lovely Act of Worship around the different forms Energy, linking them to Pentecost. Some of the children spoke in their native language as they talked about the power of the Holy Spirit. It was wonderful to hear the children sing; a wonderful celebration of Pentecost.

On Monday 6 June, we will be celebrating the coming of the Holy Spirit as we mark the beginning of the church, in particular the different ethnicities we have within our school. All children and staff are invited to wear sensible party clothes (ie no heels, football kits or strappy dresses).

In the morning, the children will learn about the symbols of Pentecost followed by taking part in creative activities within their classroom. After lunch, each class will have a class party to celebrate the birthday of the Church before heading outside to experience the Pentecost story told by several pupils in their home languages. Many thanks to the parents who have volunteered to share their family's culture as part of the celebration.

In the Advent term, two of our Year 6 pupils decided to bake and sell cookies to raise money for charity following an Act of Worship on 'Service'. Phoebe W and Elsie W did a fantastic job raising £43.10 for the RSPCA. We were delighted to finally be able to celebrate their efforts during Monday's Celebration Assembly.

Last Friday, children in KS2 had a wonderful morning celebrating Our Lady with a Marian procession. At Darley Park the children were greeted by Fr Greg, Fr Tim, Fr Phil, Deacon Chris and Bishop Raymond, along with four members of the parish community who had prepared talks for the children on famous apparitions of our Holy Mother at Walsingham, Lourdes, Guadalupe and Kibeho. The children and staff then moved on to St. Mary's Church where Bishop Raymond blessed the restored Jesse Tree window and the children scattered petals at Mary's feet. The celebration ended with a hymn 'As I Kneel Before You' which the children performed beautifully. It is hoped that this is the beginning of a revived annual Mary procession.

Congratulations also go our First Holy Communion children from St Mary's Parish who received the Sacrament on Saturday from Fr Greg and Bishop Raymond from Zimbabwe. We invite our school community to please keep all the children in your prayers.
