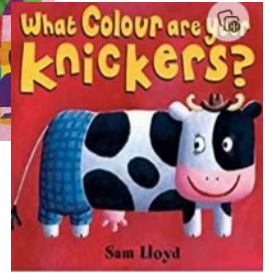
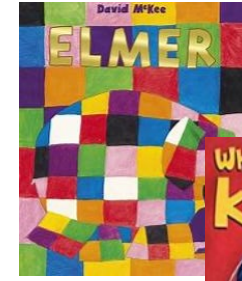
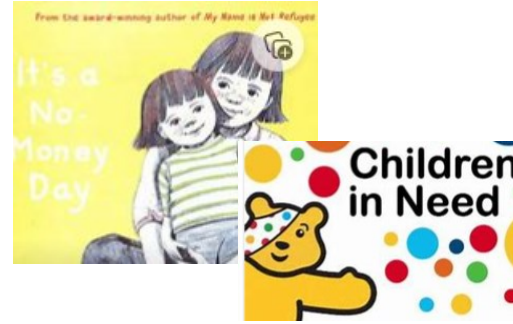
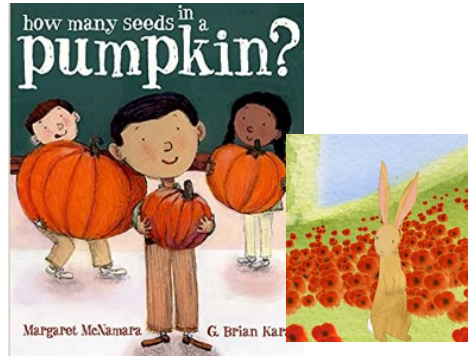


FS2: Knowledge Organiser: Advent 2 - Make a Rainbow

Make a model rocket using a cardboard tube - what colours will you choose?




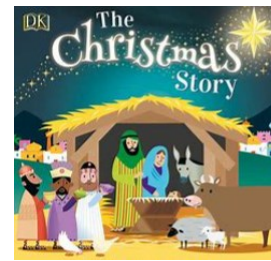
Diwali - A Hindu celebration of light. A festival to remember the story of Rama and Sita.

Can you design and draw a chalk rangoli pattern in your garden or front door?



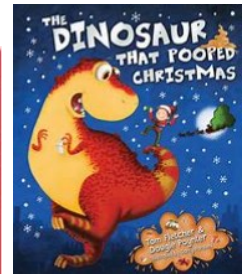
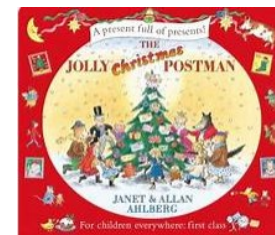
Christmas - Christians celebrate the birth of Jesus. Christmas day is celebrated on 25th December.

Literacy- Reading and Writing

At home, please encourage your child to label some of their toys using the initial sound or try to sound out the full word?



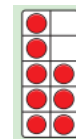
Mathematics: All about the numbers to 10

To know one number name for each object when counting.

To know how to use a ten frame.

To know how to subitise to 5.

Subitise— Remember 'to subitise use your eyes.' This is the ability to recognise a small number of objects and instantly recognise how many there are without counting e.g. dice patterns.



At home, please play game with your child using dice to encourage your child to subitise to 6 and counting objects around the house e.g. counting each step.

Expressive Arts and Design: Art / D&T

Painting and drawing focus: using colours for a purpose and specific tools for using lines and circles to represent shapes and objects.

Sculpting using salt dough / clay to make diva lamps to celebrate Diwali.
