
# FS2: Knowledge Organiser: Advent 2 - Make a Rainbow

These books will help us to learn about different celebrations. We will learn about firework




#### Autumn/Remembrance Day



#### Literacy- Reading and Writing



**Oral Segmenting** —To know this is when we split a word up into individual sounds (c-a-t) we sometimes call this robot talk.



**Blending** —To know this is when you blend the sounds together to say the word (cat).

At home practise segmenting words for your child to blend, eg, can you go to b-e-d? (bed) or "drink your m-i-l-k." (milk)





At home, please encourage your child to practise writing their name using our cursive handwriting which is on the name card previously sent home We will be learning the sounds (phonemes) for each letter of the alphabet, linking each sound to its letter (grapheme).

We will be reading simple words. "Look at the letter, make the sounds and blend the sounds together.

For children to know the first sound of the word when labelling pictures.



At home, please encourage your child to label some of their toys using the initial sound or try to sound out the full word?

To know one number name for each object when counting.

Subitise— Remember 'to subitise use your eyes.' This is the ability to recognise a small number of objects and instantly recognise how many there are without counting e.g. dice patterns.





At home, please play game with your child using dice to encourage your child to subitise to 6 and counting objects around the house e.g. counting each step.
