Isaiah 25: 8-9

Isaiah is regarded as the prophet of the expected Messiah. I know that at the time Isaiah was writing, the people were experiencing a great deal of suffering and hardship, and Isaiah's words, telling of the coming Messiah, offer them comfort, "He will wipe away the tears from everyone's eyes..."

Jeremiah 33: 14-16

I know that the messiah came from the family of David and I know some of the ancestors of Jesus

Matthew 1: 18-25

I know about Joseph, as a faithful Jew, would be familiar with the words of the prophets. Matthew points out that Joseph is a "...son of David...", because the prophets said that the promised Messiah would be descended from the great king David.

Mark13: 33
