#### Scripture

- **Psalm 23** I know this speaks of God as a shepherd looking after his sheep
- **Psalm 136** I know this demonstrates God's unconditional love for everyone even when times are hard and the challenges these passages present to Christians.
- **Isaiah 40: 1-5, 9-11, 28-31, Psalm 136** influence the beliefs and values of Christians today and in the future.
- **Luke 15: 11-32** I know this is The Parable of the prodigal Son and I can use it to explain God's unconditional love and the implications of wrong choices.
- **Matthew 5: 1-12** I know the Beatitudes are found here and their meaning for today.
- **Luke 15- 11-32** I know God's unconditional love is explained by the response of the Father in and what it means for me.
- **John 15: 9-14** and Ephesians 4: 26, 31-32 I know by living in God's way, as Jesus showed us we can grow in love.
