Dear parents, carers and stakeholders,

## RE: Consultation on the Temporary Expansion of St Benedict Catholic Voluntary Academy

We are writing to inform you that we are working closely with Derby City Council to see if we can accommodate more pupils at Saint Benedict, in Year 7 in 2023 and 2024. This is due to an expected increase in secondary student numbers across the city in those two years, based on current projections.

The St Ralph Sherwin Catholic Multi Academy Trust (SRSCMAT), Saint Benedict and Derby City Council are working together on this proposal, which is in the very early stages. Your feedback is very important to us as we move forward, and we are seeking your views.

The expansion scheme is needed to ensure the city council can deliver its statutory duty to provide enough school places across Derby. The proposed increase would see an extra 90 pupils joining Saint Benedict in 2023 and another 90 in 2024, taking the admissions number in both years, in Year 7, to 335. These pupils would gradually make their way through the school and the current admissions number of 245 would be reinstated in Year 7 in 2025.

First and foremost, we would not be expanding the school in any way that compromises on the excellent standard of education and pastoral care offered at Saint Benedict. The proposal will not mean more pupils per class, but rather expanded provision with additional staff, classes and space.

If the increase goes ahead, we would be awarded funding to alter existing buildings to create four additional classrooms ready for September 2023, along with enhancements to the existing provision. There would also be a new temporary build on the existing school site, housing classrooms focusing on Science. Any building works would be subject to a feasibility study and the usual planning consents.





As a Trust, we continue to champion the need for investment to improve facilities at Saint Benedict and this proposal very much complements the long-term vision for the school.

Your views are incredibly important to us and we would welcome your feedback on this proposal.
