





Examples of Edward Saidi Tingatinga's work



Technical Vocabulary:

Abstract art- To show objects just in terms of their lines, shapes and colours.

Stippling- the art or process of drawing, painting, or engraving using numerous small dots or specks.

Line - A line is a mark that is longer than it is wide. A line could be created using materials such as a pencil, pen, or a brush. A line can be straight or curved. It can be horizontal, vertical or diagonal, and can change direction.

Pattern - repeated lines, shapes or colours.

Composition - putting different elements together to create a picture.

Background - The part of a picture that seems furthest away.

Foreground - The part of a picture that seems closest.
