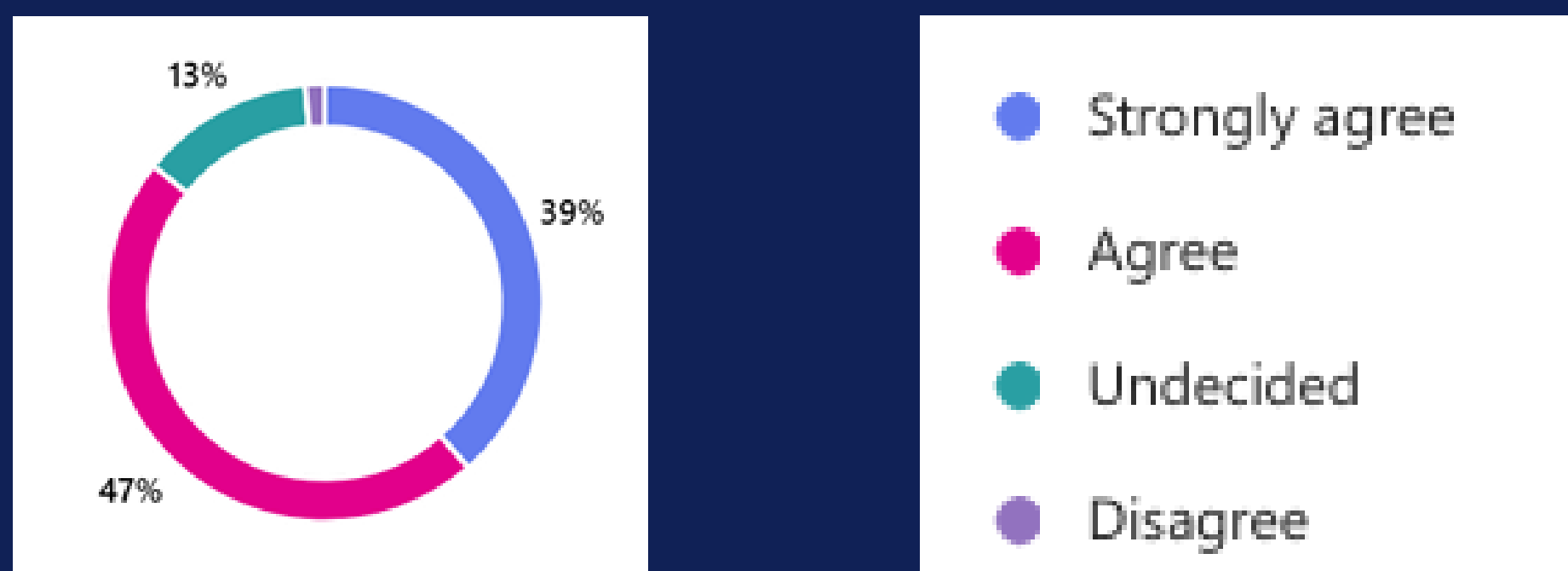

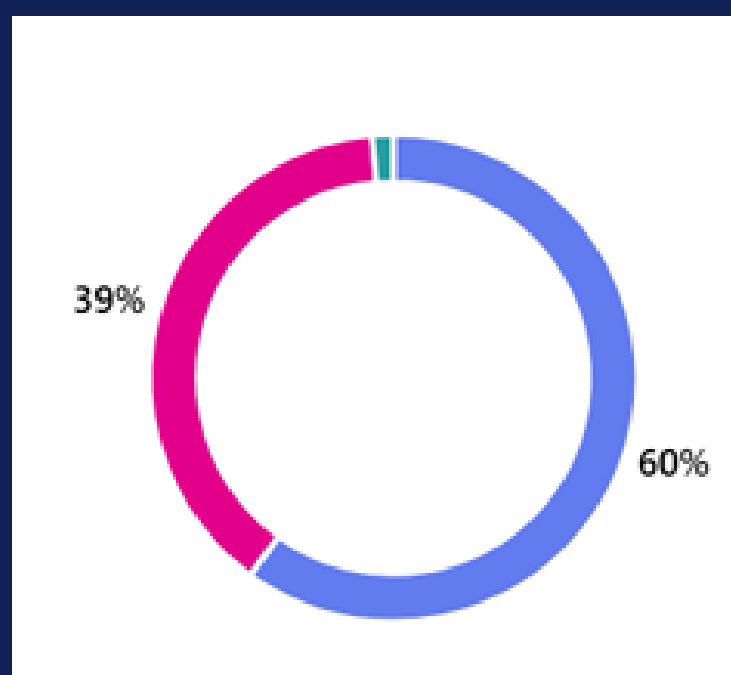

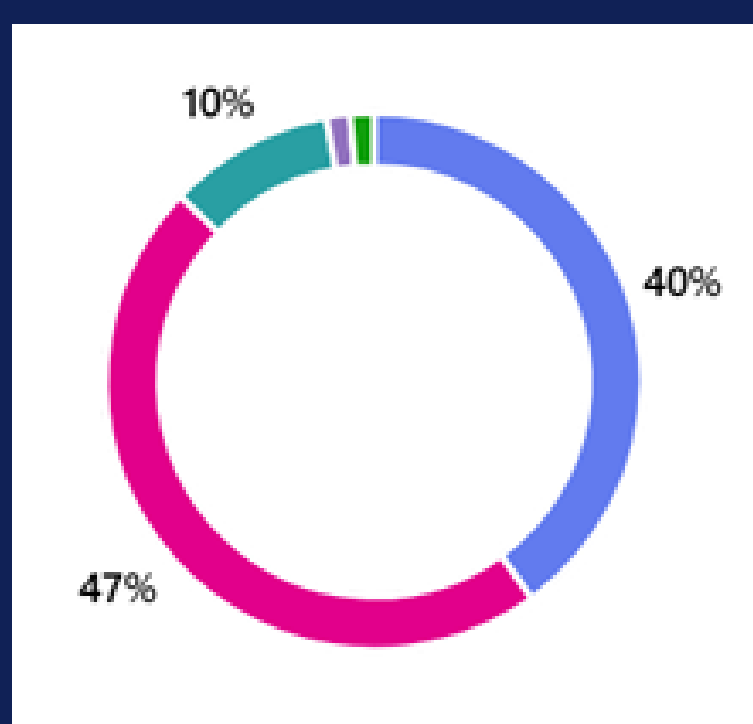
Do you trust the school's judgement in delivering the RSHE programme?



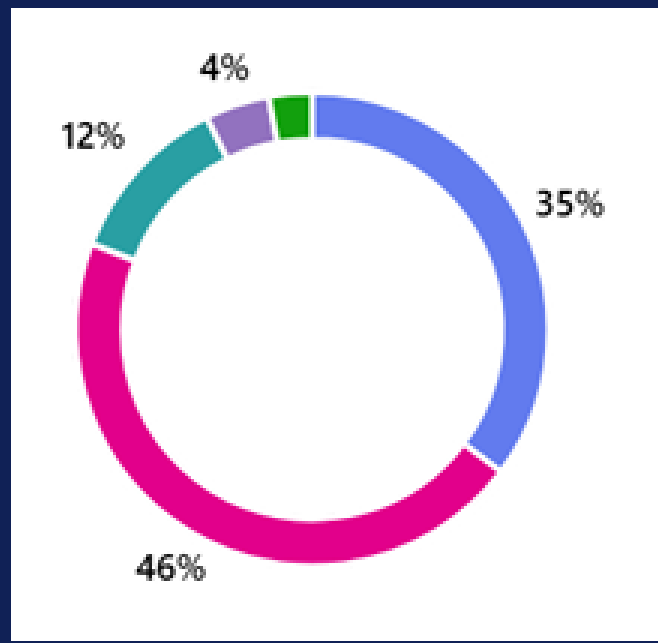
Do you understand and accept that a parent's role is as the 'first educator' of a child on matters related to teaching human sexuality?



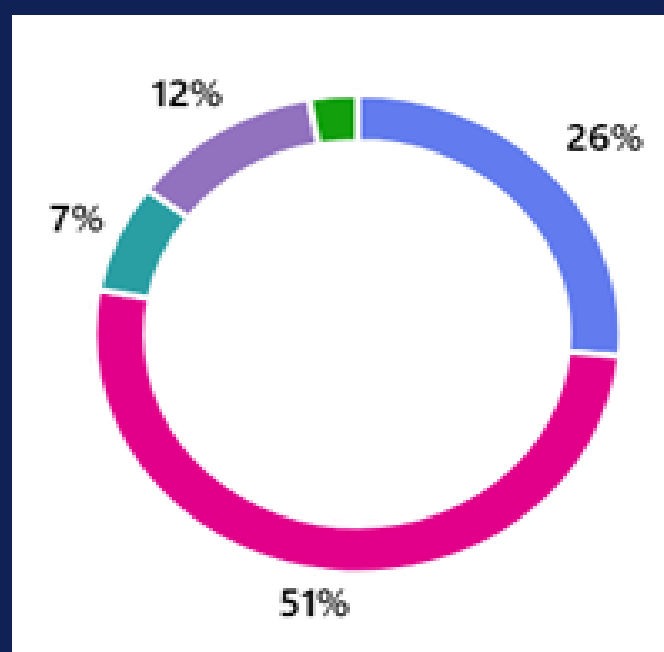
Are you comfortable with the Catholic Ethos of the programme?



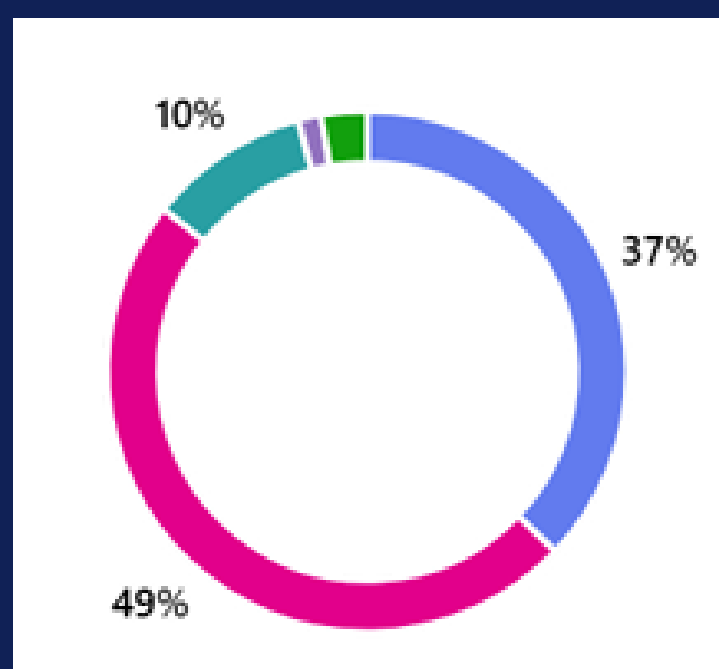
Do you feel that children in KS1 should learn the correct naming of external genitalia?
